Literacy

We will be exploring the story of the Tin Forest and writing a variety of imaginative descriptions to describe settings and characters. The children will explore the features of diary writing and challenge themselves to use sentence openers, interesting vocabulary, time connectives and conjunctions.

<u>DT</u>

In DT this half term, the children will be thinking about effective ways to repurpose an item of clothing. They will be practicing a range of basic sewing skills and exploring the best ways to cut and join fabric shapes and patterns.

<u>Art</u>

During out Art lessons, we will be exploring print making and the children will develop an understanding of how prints can be made from both natural objects and collagraph blocks.

<u>RE</u>

The world Religion we will be focusing on is Islam and learning the meaning of the word compassion.

Maths

In Maths, the children will be looking at 2D and 3D shape, exploring their properties (including lines of symmetry. They will then begin to explore multiplication by using practical resources and a variety of new pictorial methods.

<u>PE</u>

In PE, we will begin to learn the rules and skills of tennis. We will also be exploring dance and creating a sequence of movement.

Geography

In Geography this half term, the children will be learning about Rainforest and the Yanomami people. They will then begin to develop their fieldwork and mapping skills. They will look at aerial views, OS maps and begin to understanding the use of keys.

Swimming

We are very excited that the Year 2 children will be going swimming this half term. Each class will have a different slot for swimming so keep a look out for the upcoming swimming letters.

<u>Science</u>


