
Welcome to another year of learning and fun!

Mrs Wesson and her team have once again welcomed children into the Nursery. Nursery times are 8.45—11.45 am session; 12.15- 3.15 pm session and the 30 hr children attend from 9-3. The children are settling well and starting to learn routines of nursery.

Their first topic will be, **All About Me**. The children will be learning about where they live, who they live with and who cares for them.
